2. Academic References: Two confidential Academic letters of recommendation from instructors most familiar with your academic work. **Please note** that McMaster University uses the Electronic Referencing System. By entering the email address of your Academic referee through the online application, the system will automatically send an e-Reference request on your behalf. 3. Confidential letter from two persons who has known you in a professional context, mailed directly to the Nursing Graduate Program, HSC-2J41, Attention: Mary Lynn Taylor, 1280 Main Street West, Hamilton, Ontario, Canada L8S 4K1, faxed directly from your referee to 905-526-7949, or e-mailed directly from the referee to taym@mcmaster.ca . 4. Curriculum Vitae: Include list of publications and funded research grants.
5. Declaration of Employment: All applicants must complete this form. Please download the form [here](#).
6. Personal Essay. Responding to the 4 questions providing us with insight into your motivation and interest in the primary health care nurse practitioner program (PHCNP). Please download the guidelines [here](#). (one page per question, single spaced, 12 Font).
7. Health Professional Requirements: Evidence of eligibility to be registered or licensed in his/her own province/country (copy of License/Registration).
8. Verification of employment hours. Please download the form [here](#)
9. If English is not your native language, an official copy of a TOEFL score, or other evidence of competency in English is needed. A minimum TOEFL (iBT) score of 92 (580 on the paper-based TOEFL test or 237 on the computer-based TOEFL test) is required. IELTS minimum score 7.0.
